OUTSIDE is pleased to present 'Scapes', a new solo exhibition of collage and print work by North Adams based artist Anne Roecklein.

Anne Roecklein's *Scapes* invite us to contemplate our relationships with places—real, imaginary, and somewhere in between. By cutting, layering, and reconstituting discarded publications, Roecklein reanimates paper ephemera. Common vistas, facades, and content imbue her works with a sense of familiarity, but the abstracted perspectives and variations in scale belie one coherent narrative. Simultaneously everywhere and nowhere, these scapes offer a generous opportunity to consider *possibilities*—through imagination, desire, and reflection.

Scapes presents an installation of 4 collage series created by Roecklein from 2011 to 2018: *Paper Lures*, *Seaweedsapes*, *Speculative Plans*, and *Firmament*. Together the series oscillate between micro and macro scales, and their installation within the gallery serves to create dynamic relationships and overlaps between individual works.

Anne Roecklein holds a BA from Carleton College, an MPS from Pratt Institute, and an MFA from Indiana University–Bloomington. Her work has been exhibited at the Hyde Collection, Glens Falls, NY; Landmark College, Putney, VT; Albany International Airport Gallery, NY; the Begehungen Art Festival in Chemnitz, Germany; Daniel Cooney Fine Art, New York; the Lexington Art League, KY; christopher west presents, Indianapolis; PrintRoom, Rotterdam; Gallery NoMINIMO, Guayaquil, Ecuador; and other national and international venues. She lives and works in North Adams, Massachusetts.
